How to Get a Library Card at Greenwood-Leflore Public Library System in 3 Easy Steps!

1. Ask for an application card at the front desk of the library. (Parents must fill out an application card for children between the ages of 6 and 18.)
2. Patron must bring a photo ID with name and current address on it.
3. Patron must provide proof of residency with one of the following:
 - Checkbook
 - Driver's License
 - Student ID card
 - State-issued ID card
 - Utility Bill
